## BAPTISMS

Dear Friends in Christ,

On **World Mission Sunday, October 22**, our celebration leads us to hear of our Christian faith—leads us to mission, as Pope Francis explains in his message for this year's celebration.

The collection on the next-to-last Sunday in October is unique. It is truly a global effort for the entire Church. It is a central moment each year to provide for the building up of over one thousand local churches in Asia and Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe.
