## BAPTISMS

We acknowledge the blessing our parish receives when a baby is born into a parish family. Baptisms are celebrated on scheduled Saturday's of the month. Godparents must be registered in a Roman Catholic Church and attending Mass on a regular basis and able to receive a letter of recommendation from their Parish Priest. *A Word from the Pastor...*

With great excitement, I am pleased to share with you that we have received \$14,234.01 as our second payment from our parish share of the Upon This Rock proceeds. We will continue to receive semi-annual payments from the diocese as parishioners make payments to their Upon This Rock pledge commitments. You may recall that we will be setting these funds and additional payments received (totaling \$41,539.88 to date) aside in a reserve which can be tapped for future maintenance needs of our parish, such as heating and cooling and paving/parking lot repairs.

188 of our 810 registered families made \$646,623 in pledge commitments to the campaign. Our goal was \$480,000 and coupled with \$35,000 for the 2016 (only) Catholic Charities Appeal, our results were 26% above goal—something we as a faith community should be very proud of!

The \$100 million diocesan Upon This Rock campaign is almost complete with activity at a few parishes still underway. So far, more than \$104 million has been pledged across our diocese. These funds will be used to support important ministry and mission programs including bold new evangelization and catechesis initiatives, Catholic education, our seminary, campus ministry and communications, among other things.
